Guidelines for Contributors

- 1. Social Science Gazetteer welcomes articles from the members of Indian Social Science Association (ISSA) and from others. The article should be around 10,000 words and must be typed on one side of A-4 size paper.
- 2. The article should be in the following format: title, abstract (around 150 words), text of the article, tables, notes and references. No name and address of the author(s) should be found with the article, instead they could be given in the covering letter.
- 3. Send only the hard copy of the article (two copies) first. If the article is accepted for publication, the contributor(s) will be required to send the soft copy of the article through e-mail.
- 4. The author(s) are also required to give the(ir) biographical note and the address for correspondence with e-mail address(es) on a separate sheet of paper.
- 5. Use single quotation marks (except for quotation within quotation). In case of quotations, referencing in the text should be as follows: (Srinivas 1980: 163).
- 6. All references cited in the text must be listed in the References section and vice versa. References should be in the following sequence: surname, first name or initials, year of publication, title of the book (in italics), place of publication and publishers. For example: Desai, A.R. 1966. Social Background of Indian Nationalism. Bombay: Popular Prakashan. The listing in References must follow the alphabetical order.
